

Having regard for the principles for the abolition of slavery, for the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, for the Charter of the United Nations, for resolutions 1514 and 1541 of the General Assembly of the United Nations, and being *Conscious* of the proclamations of the people of the former Netherlands New Guinea during and since August 1962 opposing an agreement sponsored by the United States of America between the Republic of Indonesia and the Kingdom of the Netherlands concerning the then West New Guinea (West Irian) / West Papua ;

We the members of the sixty fifth session of the General Assembly request an advisory opinion of the International Court of Justice,

on the legality of the 1962 “*Agreement between between the Republic of Indonesia and the Kingdom of the Netherlands concerning West New Guinea (West Irian / West Papua)*”,

on the legality of the United Nations exercising article twelve of the agreement, and

on the current status of the territory in relation to resolution 1541 (principles IV and V) of the General Assembly of the United Nations.
